

## **EASTON PARISH COUNCIL**

A Parish Council meeting was advertised and held on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2014 in St Peter's Church, Easton .

Apologies for absence: no apologies received, all members present with Mr Mike Baker in the chair

**Declaration of members' interests** – to receive from members declarations as to personal and/or prejudicial interests and the nature of those interests in relation to any agenda item.

**Minutes:** Mr Wood has not been able to complete the minutes of the last meeting but confirmed these would be ready by the next meeting

**Matters arising:** Hartham Street – Mr Thomason advised the meeting that he had been told by the Rights of Way Officer that work had been started to level the ruts along Hartham Street, but following complaints the work had been stopped.

Aircraft noise – this is still an annoyance but is not illegal and is unidentifiable.

Operators Licence – Mr Purser - it was reported that an application has been submitted to VOSA at the Department of Transport.

**War Memorial:** Mr Wood reported the Easton Social & Fund Raising committee have commissioned a report from stonemasons with the intention of having renovation works carried out to the War Memorial in the churchyard. It is understood that the recommendation is to have a new piece of Westmoreland slate engraved with exactly the same names and placed on the south side of Memorial. A contribution is being requested from the Parish Council. It was agreed to this in principle, but Mr Baker wishes to check some similar work to see how this will look.

**Parish Partner Networking:** notification has been received from the Local Infrastructure & Street Management of a Parish Partner Networking Meeting to be held on 29<sup>th</sup> October at Brampton. It was agreed to reserve two places.

**Woolley Hill Wind Farm:** Cambridgeshire Community Foundation has advised the Parish Council that two representatives interested in sitting on a panel to consider grant requests for funding from the Community Fund are required. The first meeting is proposed for 24<sup>th</sup> November. It was agreed to ask if this could be circulated in the village news letter and anyone interested to contact the clerk to the Parish Council who would then forward the names on as requested. Mr Baker is to attend an open meeting to be held on 24/09/14

**Accounts:** the clerk reported the County Council had advised that the contribution of £130.71 towards the village verge cutting had been paid.
