Freedom of Information request Mr Wood had offered a resolution to Mr Goodwill which Mr Goodwill had agreed to, however it was considered that the Parish Council could not make such a commitment on behalf of the Easton United Charities and the wording should be amended to reflect this. In order to conclude this matter is was agreed that the Parish Council would agree to the request for copies of the minutes for the past fifteen years. It was suggested that Mr Goodwill be asked to pay towards the cost of providing these in addition to the copying cost although it is not expected Mr Goodwill will agree to the extra charge.
