A Parish Council meeting was advertised to be and was held in St Peter's Church, Easton on 2nd August 2018. Alasdair Graham was present to update the Parish Council with regard to the replacement defibrillator.

Minutes: the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 21st June, 2018, were read and signed as correct.

Before taking matters arising Mr Baker suggested Alasdair Graham report on the replacement defibrillator for which he has arranged funding through Highways England and Cambridgeshire Community Fund. £2,491.00 including VAT has been received for the purchase of a Wel Medical Ultimate IPAD, lockable cabinet, 10 years replacement consumables and training. It was agreed the Parish Council order this through the East Anglian Ambulance Service. Mr Graham will arrange the installation and confirm this with for Highways England who supported the finance.

Matters arising:

17/01227/FUK (16/00211/ENCOM) Barn & Stable development, Stonely Road Routine requests for up to date information from the Planning and Enforcement Departments at the District Council with regard to the unauthorised development and the length of time any determination was taking had been made. In reply to the last enquiry the Parish Council had made querying specific planning policies the Enforcement Officer had replied stating the planning policies listed are now very out of date. There is not now an objection in principle to this form of development which can be approved provided that it is appropriate and sustainable. Various other policies were quoted as relevant. It was advised that discussions are being monitored between the owner, their agent and Development Management Officers who are aware of the need to review the timing for formal action. The time limits for taking enforcement action are 4 years from the date of substantial completion for unauthorised buildings and 10 years for unauthorised uses of land.
