

EASTON PARISH COUNCIL

A Parish Council meeting was arranged and advertised, all members of the Parish Council summoned and members of the public notified and invited to join a Parish Council meeting via remote Zoom link (Coronavirus Regulations 2020) at 8.00pm on 3rd September 2020.

Mr Michael Baker, chair, opened the meeting, other members present Richard Burton, Steve Thomason and Clive Wood also welcoming those members of the public online.

- 255/2020-21 Apologies for absence received from Philip Trussell
- 256/2020-21 Declaration of financial or personal interest: to receive members' declarations as to personal and/or prejudicial interests and the nature of those interests in relation to any agenda item – Richard Burton and Clive Wood with regard to the planning consultation report
- 257/2020-21 Consideration of Minutes 06/08/2020 proposed approval and seconded by Clive Wood and Steve Thomason, signed by the Chair.
- 258/2020-21 Matters arising
- 249/2020-21 verge obstructions – none of the obstructions have been removed. Complaints received of nuisance parking of vehicles which are unable to park on verge in front of the business due to obstructions. The Highways Officer has been contacted again but no response received.
- 245/2020-21 renovation village pump – Mr Wood to remind Mr Messenger
- 213/2019-20 footpath south AWA treatment works - nothing
- 245/2020-21 Hartham Street – downgrading to bridleway – reply from Footpaths Officer saying briefly mentioned to Definitive Map Team who will look into the history and advise but downgrading a route's status is very difficult.
- Mr Trussell had reported a 4x4 completely grounded in ruts before the relaid surface from Grafham and no gate at Grafham end of Hartham Street. Footpaths Officer to be advised.
- 246/2020-21 Planning Consultation 20/00801 FUL Berrylands Parish Council comments submitted, no decision as yet.
- 247/2020-21 Goosey Close – Hand sanitiser dispenser, hand gel and notice have been purchased for installation. Mr Thomason has removed a swing set from each bay as H&S recommendation. New parts ordered from Kompan Ltd. Mr Burton to obtain quotations for playbark. Mr Wood had spoken to Mr Messenger to repair edging who will complete as soon as he has time.

- 259/2020-21 160/2020-21 Village Barn Farm
 The Enforcement Officer, who had been contacted replied stating it had not been possible to secure an application for the extension to the building and on review this would not warrant formal enforcement as if this is received it would likely be supported by the local plan policies. A number of issues had been resolved and she intended to close the investigation. The clerk requested information on the outstanding matters and that the case remain open until the Parish Council had had time to review the information. The Enforcement Officer agreed until clarification of outstanding matters and stated the only breach of planning control was the extension to the building for stabling purposes and suggested a video call but would only speak to one person. Steve Thomason agreed to speak on behalf of the Parish Council

A notice had been printed in the newsletter but no offer of location. Mr Wood advised the Church not suitable as permission from the Diocese would be too difficult.
