My report this year is brief because we have not been able to offer many events to the village.

Big Breakfasts restarted in September 2021. They take place on the second Saturday every 2 months so we have had 4 since September, raising a sum of £633.78 towards the Church insurance bill. The next breakfast is on 14th May.

There have been just 2 EFSC events in the past 12 months. The committee helped Beth and Brian Davis serve a village afternoon tea in their garden on 15th August. The event was to thank everyone who assisted those in need during the floods just before Christmas 2020. It was a lovely afternoon and so nice for everyone to mix and socialise in Beth and Brian's beautiful garden.

The next event was the Mulled Wine and Mince Pies in the Church before Christmas. This is always a popular event and it made a profit of £163.00.

We have a balance presently in our account of £669.66 but hope that that figure will increase as we roll out events for this year. A calendar of events has been circulated around the village.

I would like to thank all my Committee, especially our Treasurer, Karen Nesbit-Farrer and Secretary Simon Malivoire. All their efforts have been much appreciated in a very challenging year. I do hope that 2022/23 will be a less fraught and more socially interactive year for our village.
