#### **NATURE NOTE 90**

On 18<sup>th</sup> May this year I received an email from the secretary of the Cambridge Bird Club, Michael Holdsworth, asking for all records of Spotted flycatchers nesting in the county. This is one of the migrant species that has been showing a marked decline in recent years. They have nested against our house for many years and sure enough, three days later, a pair arrived in our garden. On the 24<sup>th</sup> I saw them prospecting a little nesting tray which I had made and put up under

the eaves of the shed beside our house ten years or more ago. On the 29<sup>th</sup> I put up a ladder while the birds were away and felt the nest with two eggs in it. It seems as if the female only lays an egg every second or third day for it appeared briefly, with its mate, snuggled down for two minutes, and then flew off again. This photograph was taken on the 31<sup>st</sup> May through the drawing-

room window. Some days later I checked the nest again using a mirror and could see five eggs, and by 18<sup>th</sup> June both birds were busy collecting insects to stuff down gaping beaks. There don't seem to be any other pairs of Spotted flycatchers in Easton this year but the Watsons at Barham and the Crofts at Stow Longa do have pairs, and Michael Holdsworth is keen to put rings on the fledglings when they are about a week old to help trace their movements. So far he has found fewer than 20 nests in the whole of Cambridgeshire so we are certainly doing our bit in this corner of the county. I know they have nested at Eversden Cottage and at Oversland in the past and there must have been many broods raised in Easton over the years, so you may like to consider putting up a nesting tray like this one in my photograph in a suitable place to attract a pair in future...
